Here's an overview of the four sections of the test:



READING

60 - 80 MINUTES | 36 - 56 QUESTIONS
Read passages, then respond to questions



LISTENING

60 - 90 MINUTES | 34 - 51 QUESTIONS
Listen to brief lectures or a classroom discussion, then respond to questions

BREAK

10-MINUTE BREAK FOR ALL TEST TAKERS



SPEAKING

20 MINUTES | 6 TASKS
Using a microphone, speak about familiar topics, and also discuss material you read about and listened to



WRITING

50 MINUTES | 2 TASKS
Read a passage, listen to a recording and then type your response

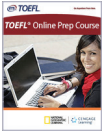
